This position also manages the Accounting, Operations, and Finance divisions within the agency. The ideal candidate will have stellar management skills, strategic acumen and a collaborative nature. This candidate will also have a strong understanding of financial management within state government and/or the lending industry, with some experience with the issuance of mortgage revenue bonds preferred. This role will be a key advisor to the Executive Director providing information to assist in the making of decisions that support the best interests of the agency and its programs, as well as presenting budgetary reports to THDA's Board of Directors, and the Tennessee State Legislature.

This position is a hybrid of in-office and telecommuting after the successful completion of a six (6) month probationary period, and an agreed upon schedule with the Executive Director.

THDA is a dynamic organization with a focus firmly in the housing industry. Our mission is **to meaningfully expand affordable housing** by promoting the production and preservation of affordable new and existing housing units for very low-, low- and moderate-income individuals and families.
