HUD Posts Materials for Simplifying Operations Webinar

On the <u>HCV Program Trainings and Resources</u> webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted the <u>recording</u> and <u>presentation slides</u> for the "HCV Utilization: Simplifying Operations" webinar that was held on December 15, 2022. During the live web conference, HUD updated HCV program administrators on program options housing authorities may use to simplify operations. The webinar covered topics such as biennial and triennial inspections, remote video inspections, streamlined reexaminations, and other HCV program policies.

HUD Posts Materials for ConnectHome Virtual Summit

On the <u>HUD Exchange News webpage</u>, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>) announced that it has posted the <u>materials</u> for the three-day virtual summit on timely digital inclusion topics that was held for ConnectHomeUSA (<u>CHUSA</u>) communities, public housing authorities, tribes, multifamily housing owners and operators, public-private stakeholders, and others interested in digital inclusion.

During the event, which took place from October 25 to October 27, 2022, participants heard from a wide range of organizations, from federal agencies tasked with administering new broadband funding programs, private-sector stakeholders who provided updates about their programs, to CHUSA communities that had innovative programs to share. The summit featured training webinars and breakout sessions, which allowed participants to engage directly with speakers and leave with tools for continued growth.
