HUD Posts Interactive Diagram on Fair Housing Complaint Process

On the [HUD Exchange News](#) webpage, HUD’s Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity (FHEO) [announced](#) that it has posted an [interactive diagram](#) to help housing providers understand their obligations if named as a respondent in a [Fair Housing Act](#) investigation. The six-page interactive diagram provides simple clarification of the complaint process along with helpful resources. It covers the following subject areas:

- Equal treatment under the law
- Notification of a filed complaint
- The complaint process
- Conciliation
- Resolution of the case
- Tips and resources

The Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), disability, and familial status.
