HUD Announces New MTW HCV Utilization Dashboard

On the Moving to Work ([MTW](#)) Demonstration program webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that a new [MTW Housing Choice Voucher \(HCV\) Utilization Dashboard](#) is now available. According to the announcement:

The MTW HCV Utilization Dashboard is a public-facing resource for end-users to access information about how MTW PHAs use their HCV funds. The dashboard is a snapshot of MTW PHAs' reported housing assistance payments, annual HCV budget authority, HCV reserves, and the details of how MTW PHAs intend to use HCV reserves in their local communities.

PD&R Opens Competition for Secretary's Award

HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research ([PD&R](#)) has posted a "call for entries" for the [2023 Secretary's Award for Public-Philanthropic Partnerships – Housing and Community Development in Action](#). The application deadline for the award, which emphasizes partnerships between the philanthropic and public sectors, is **February 24, 2023**.

The award, sponsored by HUD in partnership with the [Council on Foundations](#), recognizes excellence in partnerships that have both transformed the relationships between the sectors and led to measurable benefits in terms of increased economic employment, health, safety, education, disaster resilience, inclusivity and cultural opportunities, innovative regional approaches, and/or housing access for low and moderate-income families.

Examples of desired nominations may include projects affiliated with housing and neighborhood improvements, education, health and recreation, transportation, community participation, arts and culture, safety, disaster response, innovative regional approaches, and economic development.
