HUD Publishes Fall 2023 Issue of *Evidence Matters*

HUD’s Office of Policy Development and Research ([PD&R](#)) has published the [Fall 2023](#) issue of [Evidence Matters](#). PD&R provides this introduction to the 36-page issue, which focuses on office-to-residential conversions:

The United States is facing a severe lack of housing stock, and this shortage is exacerbating the nation’s lack of affordable housing. Those affected are not only people who want to live close to employment centers in central business districts in urban areas but also renters and buyers nationwide. Since the outset of the pandemic, utilization of downtown office space has heavily decreased in cities across the U.S. This edition of *Evidence Matters* examines the advantages and drivers of adaptive reuse of office buildings and office-to-residential conversion. This issue also focuses on existing regulatory, logistical, and financial barriers to conversion when attempting to revive American cities after office space utilization decreased during and after the pandemic.
