HUD Posts Public Housing Repositioning Webinar Materials

On the [HUD Exchange News webpage](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced that it has posted the materials for the webinar titled “[You Have SAC Approval - What Now?](#),” the latest in its series “[Public Housing Repositioning](#),” which explains and discusses common issues in the repositioning process.

The webinar, held on September 28, 2022, provided an overview of the steps PHAs must take to implement a Special Applications Center ([SAC](#)) approval. Panelists discussed the following:

- Use agreements and releases of the Declaration of Trust (DOT)
- Applying for Tenant Protection Vouchers ([TPVs](#)) and resident relocation
- Impacts on PHAs’ operating and capital funding
- Project-Based Vouchers ([PBV](#)) at the property
- PIH Information Center ([PIC](#)) and proceeds reporting requirements
- Real Estate Assessment Center ([REAC](#)) inspections
- Informing HUD of delayed and changed plans
- Repositioning resources available to facilitate a smooth transition
