## PD&R to Hold Quarterly Update Event on Transit-Oriented Development

HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research (PD&R) has announced that it will be holding a <u>quarterly update event</u> titled "Opportunities to Advance Equitable Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) that Supports Affordable Housing Production." The first panel at the event will look at TOD projects that promote affordable housing options near transit, while also enabling all community members—regardless of income, ethnicity, gender, or ability—to enjoy mixed-use, walkable neighborhoods. The second panel will explore opportunities to leverage existing and future transportation resources at the federal, state, and local level to build more affordable housing near transit.

The quarterly update event will be held virtually and in person at HUD Headquarters in Washington, D.C., on Wednesday, November 20, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Eastern time. To register, click <a href="here">here</a>.
