HUD Announces VAWA Training Series

On the [HCV Program Trainings and Resources](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it will be holding a training series on the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA). The first course will provide an overview of VAWA housing protections for survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking as well as VAWA requirements specific to PHAs. It will also discuss VAWA's intersection with the prevalence of gender-based violence (GBV) and homelessness. PHAs will gain a better understanding of how to comply with VAWA's housing provisions and the impact of those obligations on housing operations throughout the occupancy cycle.
