HUD Awards \$160.1 Million to Support Affordable Housing for Low-Income Seniors

In a <u>press release</u> yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) announced that it has awarded \$160.1 million in grants to nonprofit organizations across the country to support the development of new or redeveloped affordable multifamily rental housing and ongoing project-based rental assistance for low-income seniors.

The awards, provided under the <u>Section 202</u> Supportive Housing for the Elderly program, will facilitate the construction and operation of 1,262 new deeply rent-assisted units for low and very low-income seniors. Several grantees will create mixed-income communities, building 526 additional affordable and market-rate units as part of these funded projects for a total of 1,788 homes. A list of the grant recipients and the amounts they were awarded are included in the press release.

Section 202 grants provide low-income elderly persons 62 years of age or older with the opportunity to live independently in an environment that provides necessary services to meet their unique needs.
