## Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base Module Now Open in OpFund Web Portal

In an <u>email</u> yesterday via the Financial Management Division (FMD) <u>mailing list</u>, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>) announced that the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base (SR-FRB) election module is now open in the <u>operating fund web portal</u>.

For CY 2023, PHAs must make elections or change requests to SR-FRB no later than **December 16, 2022.** Follow the steps included in the <u>email</u> to find HUD's list of PHAs eligible to participate in SR-FRB. Note that the SR-FRB program is only eligible for PHAs with 550 or fewer combined public housing units and vouchers under Section 8(o). Review Notice <u>PIH 2022-32</u> for additional information.
