HUD Announces \$1.3 Million to Prevent Youth Homelessness

In a [press release](#) last Friday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it is awarding \$1.3 million to 21 PHAs across 15 states through the Foster Youth to Independence ([FYI](#)) program. The funds will provide housing assistance to young adults who left foster care or are transitioning out of foster care and are experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness. A complete list of awardees and the amounts they will receive can be found in the press release

According to the announcement, funding remains available for additional on-demand FYI assistance under Notice [PIH 2023-04](#). The notice allocated \$30 million to PHAs to apply for funding on demand as eligible youth were identified and referred to the PHA through their partnering Public Child Welfare Agencies (PCWA).
