HUD Announces ConnectHome Summit

The Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) has [announced](#) that it will be hosting the 2024 ConnectHomeUSA ([CHUSA](#)) summit, a three-day event that will bring together a wide range of organizations with important connections to broadband and digital inclusion.

During the summit, participants will hear directly from federal agencies managing grant programs supporting broadband and learn how communities can prepare for opportunities that the Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment ([BEAD](#)) and Digital Equity Act ([DEA](#)) programs provide at the local level. Attendees will also have the opportunity to engage with nonprofit organizations, digital inclusion advocates, private sector organizations, and CHUSA communities. The event will feature workshop-style sessions, peer exchanges, panel discussions, and networking opportunities with stakeholders.

The summit, presented in person and virtually, will take place from December 10 to December 12, 2024. **In-person attendance is exclusively for existing Tier 1 and Tier 2 CHUSA communities** responsible for program implementation.
