PIH Publishes Inventory of Projects Eligible for Operating Fund in 2023

In an <u>email</u> last Friday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) <u>mailing list</u>, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>) announced that it has published the inventory of public housing developments eligible for Operating Fund (OpFund) grants for the 2023 funding year in the <u>OpFund web portal</u>.

According to the email, HUD will deploy the OpFund tools for the forms HUD-52723 and HUD-52722 based on the inventory. PHAs should review their inventory and contact their local field office to identify any corrections by **November 30**, **2022**. This includes projects that should be added to the inventory because the projects are eligible for operating funds in CY 2023 and projects that should be removed from the inventory because the projects are not eligible for operating funds in CY 2023.

PIH to Host Training Sessions on How to Apply for SR-FRB Incentive

In another <u>email</u> last Friday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) <u>mailing list</u>, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) announced that it is hosting two training sessions on the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base (SR-FRB) program. During the training, HUD will demonstrate how eligible PHAs can elect to participate and how to revise existing SR-FRBs.

Note that the SR-FRB program is only eligible for PHAs with 550 or fewer combined public housing units and vouchers under Section 8(o). The email includes the steps to find the list of PHAs eligible to participate. Please review Notice <u>PIH 2022-32</u> for further information. Trainings dates and times are as follows:

- <u>Tuesday, November 15, 2022</u> (10:30–11:30 a.m. Eastern time)
- Wednesday, November 16, 2022 (1:30–2:30 p.m. Eastern time)
