HUD Announces Latest in PHA Occupancy Webinar Series

The latest scheduled webinar, titled "Physical Needs Assessment (PNA)," will improve PHA grantee knowledge about the PNA HUD resources and PNA resources to help house more families, assist with repositioning efforts, and identify capital needs.
