HUD Posts FY 2022 FUP NOFO Materials

Yesterday we reported that HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>) issued a <u>notice</u> in the *Federal Register* announcing the publication of a <u>preview</u> of the fiscal year 2022 Family Unification Program (<u>FUP</u>) notice of funding opportunity (<u>NOFO</u>) in advance of its publication on <u>Grants.gov</u>.
