HUD to Host Interactive Training on HUD-52723/52722 Online Submission

In an <u>email</u> yesterday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) <u>mailing_list</u>, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>) announced that it will be hosting an interactive training on the new online submission module for the forms HUD-52723 and HUD-52722 on Tuesday, **December 6, 2022**, at 1:30 p.m. Eastern time. The training, a follow-up session of the two trainings held in November 29 and 30, will be an open forum to answer PHAs questions and concerns live. Further details can be found in the email. The new online submission module replaces the Excel tools for the forms and introduces new enhancements for PHAs. Some of the enhancements include the ability to review three-year historical data from past forms and the ability to upload supporting documents as PHAs complete their forms.


