PIH Issues Notice on EHV's Cash Management and Closeout Procedures

Late yesterday HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) published Notice [PIH 2023-35](#) describing the Emergency Housing Vouchers ([EHVs](#)) program cash management procedures for the disbursement and reconciliation of housing assistance payments (HAP) and administrative fee funds provided to participating PHAs, including Moving-to-Work (MTW) agencies. PIH will use the EHV program HAP cash reconciliation procedures for the closeout of EHV programs. The notice also provides supplemental guidance to Notice [PIH 2021-15](#) Section 7 (b), regarding the EHV program contract renewal calculation. Specifically, the 13-page document covers the following topics:

- Supplemental Information to Notice PIH 2021-15
- Cash Management Requirements
- EHV HAP Disbursements and Reconciliation Procedures
- Program Reserves and PHA-Held Balances
- Moving to Work (MTW) PHAs
- Recording Funding on Financial Statements
- EHV Administrative Fees, Placement Fees and Issuance Fees Disbursement and Reconciliation Procedures
- Closeout Procedures

HUD Awards \$10 million for Family Unification Program Vouchers

In a [press release](#) yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has awarded \$10 million to 13 PHAs nationwide to identify youth with a history of foster care involvement who are homeless or at risk of homelessness and families whose lack of adequate housing is the primary reason their children are in foster care. The funding, provided through the Family Unification Program ([FUP](#)), will make available more than 600 vouchers. The news release provides a state-by-state breakdown of the FUP funding awarded.



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
