HUD Offers Free Limited Technical Assistance for SR-FRB Program

In an email yesterday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it is offering limited direct technical assistance to PHAs participating or planning to participate in the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base ([SR-FRB](#)) program at no charge on a first come first serve basis. According to the email, consultants will assist with examining bills and identifying opportunities at your PHAs for installing effective energy conservation measures to reduce energy consumption and maximize the benefit of SR-FRB participation, which is 100 percent of savings for up to 20 years. HUD Posts File Showing Stability Vouchers Awarded by PHA and CoC

The Stability Voucher program makes housing choice voucher assistance available through a competitive process to PHAs that are partnering with local CoCs and/or victim service providers to assist households experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness, fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking; and veterans and families that include a veteran family member that meets one of the proceeding criteria.
