HUD Releases Report on Housing Needs of Survivors of Human Trafficking

In a [press release](#) yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has released a report that assesses the availability and accessibility of housing and services for survivors of human trafficking, or at risk of being trafficked, who are experiencing homelessness or housing instability. The 91-page report, titled “Housing Needs of Survivors of Human Trafficking Study,” explored the following topics:

- Methods of conducting outreach to survivors and assessing their needs
- Availability of resources for housing and services
- Access to mainstream housing and services
- Barriers to fair housing
- Best practices in housing and service delivery
