HUD Announces VMS Updates

In an email sent to executive directors, HUD's Financial Management Center (FMC) advised PHAs of new fields and updated field names available in the Voucher Management System (VMS). According to the email, the following changes are now visible and ready for use in the system effective in the January reporting period:

New fields:

- EHV Unexpended Service Fees
- · Housing mobility-related services expenditures
- Housing mobility-related services expenditures (MTW)

HOTMA/Permissive Deduction fields: these fields are visible and ready for use in the system but should not be reported in until the changes are made to the HUD-50058 in HIP.

- HCV HAP Spent on Permissive Deductions
- Mainstream HAP Spent on Permissive Deductions
- Non-HAP Expenses Spent on Permissive Deductions
- EHV HAP Spent on Permissive Deductions

Updated field names:

- Stability Vouchers (formerly Housing Stability Vouchers)
- MTW Stability Vouchers HAP Expenses After the First of the Month (formerly MTW Housing Stability Vouchers HAP Expenses After the First of the Month)
- Stability Vouchers Number of New Vouchers Issued but not Under HAP Contract as of the
 last day of the month (formerly Housing Stability Vouchers Number of New Vouchers
 Issued but not Under HAP Contract as of the last day of the month)

The email also announces that the updated <u>User's Manual</u> and <u>Quick Reference Guide</u> are available in VMS.
