HUD Publishes AAFs for Section 8 Contract Rents

Today in the *Federal Register*, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) published the <u>notice</u> of 2024 annual adjustment factors (AAFs) for Section 8 contract rents. These AAFs apply to all units in two categories of Section 8 programs:

- Category 1—the new construction, substantial rehabilitation, and moderate rehabilitation programs
- Category 2—the loan management set-aside and property disposition programs

The contract rent AAFs do **not** apply to the Housing Choice Voucher (<u>HCV</u>) program. The factors are based on a formula using residential rent and utility cost changes from the most recent annual Consumer Price Index (<u>CPI</u>) survey and market rents from a total of six possible private sector rent data sources. The 2024 HCV inflation factors will be published at a later date in a separate *Federal Register* notice.

The 2024 contract rent AAFs are not actually included in today's notice, but have been posted on the <u>AAF page</u> at the <u>HUD User website</u>. A link to the AAF tables is provided in the notice. The AAFs are published in two tables, each with two columns. For instructions on how to find the appropriate AAF, see section IV of the notice.

The 2024 contract rent AAFs are effective today, April 1, 2024.

HUD to Host SF-425 Shortfall Funding Submission Training

In an <u>email</u> last Friday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) <u>mailing list</u>, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>) announced that it has opened the SF-425 Federal Financial Report module for operating fund shortfall grants in advance of April 16, 2024. The PHA's executive director is required to submit the form. Submissions for the reporting period ending 12/31/2023 are due by May 31, 2024.


