#### **PIH Posts List of RAD Transfers**

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted the <u>list</u> of 2022 Rental Assistance Demonstration (<u>RAD</u>) transfers to the CY <u>2022 operating fund grant processing page</u>. The document lists the obligation and max RAD transfer amounts for January and February, and March and April, by PHA code. The document also lists the physical development, application number, removal action date, number of RAD units removed, standing ACC units, and the cumulative percent.
