New FSS Online Training Now Available

The Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) has [announced](#) that a new mandatory online training for Family Self-Sufficiency ([FSS](#)) staff is now ready and available to complete. The training provides FSS coordinators and HUD and PHA staff with guidance on how to develop and administer a successful and effective FSS program.

According to the announcement, at least one person from every FSS program, PBRA or PHA, funded or unfunded, is required to complete the training by **July 31, 2024**. For grantees, HUD will be looking for at least one completion for each grant. HUD notes that the training is required even if you completed the old HUD FSS online training and/or any training or certification from a third party. Grantees that do not complete the training by the deadline will have their current grant suspended until they are in compliance.
