PIH Publishes FY 2023 Tenant Protection Voucher Awards

In a *Federal Register* [notice](#) today, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) announced the tenant protection voucher (TPV) funding awards for fiscal year 2023. The document lists the PHAs, the number of vouchers, and the dollar amount of their noncompetitive funding awards for assisting households affected by housing conversion actions, public housing relocations and replacements, and moderate rehabilitation replacements. In all, 12,694 vouchers and \$139,642,219 in funding were awarded for tenant protection activities.

The notice also includes a link to the TPV [dashboard](#), which provides information for TPV actions awarded in fiscal year (FY) 2020 and beyond, sorting by state, PHA, and the year the TPV action occurred. The dashboard is updated annually following publication of TPV awards in the *Federal Register*. HUD Posts FYI Initiative NOFO Training Slides

Yesterday on the Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) Initiative webpage, HUD posted the slide deck for the FY 2024 FYI Competitive NOFO training. The notice sets forth the application and eligibility requirements, provides guidance on how to request funding, and outlines eligible uses for the administrative fees.
