## **HUD Posts Materials for Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base Program Webinar**

On the <u>HUD Exchange News</u> webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) <u>announced</u> that it has posted the materials for the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base (<u>SR-FRB</u>) program webinar that was held in March. The webinar provides an overview of the program and explains how to maximize its financial benefits. The posted materials include the <u>recording</u>, <u>slides</u>, and <u>transcript</u>.

The webinar is intended for rural PHAs with a portfolio of 550 housing units or less of combined public housing units and housing choice vouchers. Under the SR-FRB program, eligible small rural PHAs can freeze their three-year rolling base consumption level that is used to calculate operating subsidy grants.
