HUD Posts Materials for Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base Program Webinar

On the [HUD Exchange News](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) [announced](#) that it has posted the materials for the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base (SR-FRB) program webinar that was held in March. The webinar provides an overview of the program and explains how to maximize its financial benefits. The posted materials include the [recording](#), [slides](#), and [transcript](#).

The webinar is intended for rural PHAs with a portfolio of 550 housing units or less of combined public housing units and housing choice vouchers. Under the SR-FRB program, eligible small rural PHAs can freeze their three-year rolling base consumption level that is used to calculate operating subsidy grants.
