## **HUD Posts HCV Utilization Webinar Materials**

On the <u>HCV Program Trainings and Resources</u> webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted the <u>recording</u> and <u>presentation slides</u> for the "HCV Utilization: Payment Standards, Rent Burdens, and Waivers" webinar that was held on March 17, 2022.

The live web conference featured an in-depth discussion of payment standards, rent burdens, and waivers. It also included a live creation and analysis of a Payment Standard Tool (PST). The PST assists PHAs in seeing the programmatic implications of a payment standard change on both rent burden and per-unit cost.

## **HUD Posts Resources for Youth Homelessness Demonstration NOFA**

HUD <u>announced</u> that it has posted various resources related to the notice of funding availability (<u>NOFA</u>) for the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (<u>YHDP</u>) that was <u>published</u> on March 24, 2022. As you recall, the Department is making \$72 million in competitive funding available to up to 25 communities to develop and implement coordinated community approaches to prevent and end youth homelessness. The resources posted to the <u>YHDP webpage</u> include:

- The YHDP NOFA, including a link to the Grants.gov webpage.
- <u>Recording</u>, <u>presentation slides</u>, <u>transcript</u>, and a <u>chat log</u> of the FY 2021 YHDP NOFA webinar.
- Rural CoCs: This file lists all Continuums of Care (CoCs) that are considered rural for the YHDP FY 2021 competition if the application covers the entire geographic area of the CoC.
- Rural area worksheet: Applicants should use this tool if they are considering applying for less than the entire area covered by the CoC.
- A <u>debriefing document</u> from previous YHDP competition with no community scores to
  assist communities who did not apply or did not pass the threshold in their FY 2019/2020
  YHDP application. This document has general comments from reviewers on how
  applications could be improved.
- Appendix A of the NOFA, which describes the project selection process.
- Appendix B of the NOFA, which establishes the detailed requirements for the Coordinated Community Plan (CCP) under YHDP.

Applications for this NOFA must be completed and submitted by June 28, 2022.
