### HUD Publishes 2022 Inflation Factor for Civil Monetary Penalties

Today in the *Federal Register*, HUD's Office of General Counsel ([OGC](#)) published a [notice](#) which provides the 2022 inflation adjustment factor for HUD's civil monetary penalty (CMP) regulations. Such adjustments are required under the [Federal Civil Penalties Inflation Adjustment Act of 1990](#), as amended by the Federal Civil Penalties Inflation Adjustment Act Improvements Act of 2015.

As explained in the notice, the cost-of-living adjustment multiplier for 2022 is 1.06222. Adjustments are rounded to the nearest dollar. The notice includes a table showing the previous amounts and 2022 adjusted amounts for various HUD-related civil penalties. For example, the maximum monetary penalty for a first-time violation of the [Fair Housing Act](#) has increased from \$21,663 to \$23,011.

The effective date for the 2022 inflation adjustment is May 26, 2022.

### PD&R to Hold Quarterly Update Panel on Intersectionality of Youth Homelessness

HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research ([PD&R](#)) has announced that it will be holding a [quarterly update event](#) focused on the intersectionality of youth homelessness. The event, which will bring together different voices, experiences, and expertise, will look at how an intersectional lens can inform more effective responses when working with youth experiencing homelessness. According to the announcement, experts will discuss how to incorporate voices of lived expertise in the program planning process, connections between different support systems (including foster care and juvenile justice), lessons learned from service providers, and research and data needs. The event will also provide attendees with an update on U.S. housing market conditions, as well as a look at Census Household Pulse Survey data.
