HUD Posts HCV Landlord Newsletter

HUD Awards \$15 Million to Help Low-Income Seniors Age in Place

In a <u>press release</u> yesterday, HUD announced that it has awarded almost \$15 million to 13 nonprofit organizations, in addition to a state government, to assist in undertaking comprehensive programs that make safety and functional home modifications and limited repairs to meet the needs of low-income elderly homeowners.

The funds, provided through HUD's Older Adults Home Modification Program (OAHMP), will enable older adults to remain in their homes rather than move to nursing homes or other assisted care facilities. The grantees will deliver home modification services to more than 1,900 senior families in both urban communities and communities with substantial rural populations.
