HUD Opens Applications for Veteran Housing Rehab Grants

Wednesday on <u>Grants.gov</u>, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) <u>announced</u> that it is making available \$6,445,980 in funding for the Veterans Housing Rehabilitation and Modification Pilot Program (<u>VHRMP</u>). Through the VHRM program, the funds are awarded to nonprofit organizations and may be used to rehabilitate and modify the primary residence of veterans who are low-income and living with disabilities or to provide grantees' affiliates with technical, administrative, and training support in connection with those services. Grants will be competitively awarded up to \$1 million each to selected applicants. The application deadline date is **August 31, 2023**. You can find more information on the VHRM NOFA <u>here</u>.
