HUD Announces Waivers to Help MS Recover from Storms and Tornadoes

The Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) has [announced](#) a package of [29 regulatory and administrative waivers](#) aimed at helping communities in Mississippi accelerate their recovery from severe storms, straight-line winds, and tornadoes.

The regulatory and administrative relief covers the following programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), Housing Trust Fund (HTF), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Continuum of Care (CoC). The memorandum also announces a simplified notification process for grantees of these programs to use the suspension and waiver flexibility of CPD statutory and regulatory requirements to expedite the delivery of assistance.
