HUD Posts NOFOs for LRAD and Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building

Last Thursday on [grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](https://www.hud.gov)) posted the notices of funding opportunity (NOFOs) for both the 2022 Lead Risk Assessment Demonstration ([LRAD](https://www.hud.gov)) program and the [Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building Grant Program](https://www.hud.gov). While both grants were posted this year, they are listed as funded under 2022 on HUD's [Funding Opportunities](https://www.hud.gov) website.

The purpose of the LRAD program is to "demonstrate the feasibility of conducting Lead-Based Paint Risk Assessments or Lead Hazard Screens in pre-1978 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) units occupied or to be occupied by children under the age of six." The [NOFO](https://www.hud.gov) makes approximately \$50,000,000 available under the program. The application deadline is **June 20, 2023**.

The [Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building NOFO](https://www.hud.gov) makes approximately \$50,000,000 available to assist states, tribes with an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) authorized lead abatement certification program, cities, counties, parishes, or other units of local government who have not received a HUD lead hazard control grant or been a sub-recipient of such a grant since January 1, 2010, in developing the infrastructure necessary to undertake comprehensive programs to identify and control lead-based paint hazards in eligible privately owned rental or owner-occupied housing. The application deadline date is **June 27, 2023**.
