PIH Announces 2022 Renewal Funding Allocations

In a [letter to executive directors](#) last week, HUD's Financial Management Division ([FMD](#)) announced the allocation of calendar year (CY) 2022 housing assistance payment (HAP) renewal funds for the Housing Choice Voucher ([HCV](#)) program. Directors also received a spreadsheet document showing renewal funding for the individual PHA. The final HAP renewal proration factor is 100 percent. While the letter states that an accompanying PIH notice is forthcoming, the notice has yet to be posted to [HUDClips](#). If a PHA has questions related to the calculations, the PHA should contact its financial analyst at the Financial Management Center ([FMC](#)).

PIH Reminds PHAs to Request Operating Funds for New Projects

In an email yesterday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) reminded PHAs that they must request funding for new projects no later than **June 1, 2022**. PHAs must submit requests by email to their local field office. The email must include the project development number and the text requesting funding for the new project. If the new project is eligible for funding, HUD will deploy Excel tools for the forms HUD-52723 and HUD-52722 and notify PHAs via email no later than June 15, 2022. PHAs must submit the Excel tools using the OpFund web portal by June 22, 2022. Submissions received after June 22, 2022, may not be considered for funding in CY 2022. HUD Publishes 2022 ROSS-SC NOFA

Yesterday on [grants.gov](#), HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) [published](#) the fiscal year (FY) 2022 notice of funding availability ([NOFA](#)) for the Resident Opportunity and Self-Sufficiency ([ROSS](#)) service coordinator ([ROSS-SC](#)) program. The NOFA makes approximately \$35,000,000 available for the provision of service coordinators for supportive services and other activities designed to help public housing residents attain economic and housing self-sufficiency.
