PD&R Publishes Relocation Act Income Limits for FY 2023

HUD’s Office of Policy Development and Research ([PD&R](#)) has posted [low income limits](#) for fiscal year (FY) 2023 under the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 ([URA](#)). The income limits are used to determine whether a displaced person is considered “low income” for purposes of calculating relocation assistance payments.

The effective date for the FY 2023 income limits is May 15, 2023. For more information, see the [income limit area definitions](#) and the [income limit tables](#).
