PIH Posts Explanation of June and July Obligations

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) has <u>posted</u> a <u>document</u> explaining public housing operating fund obligations for June and July 2023. According to the document, June and July obligations are based on the interim eligibility determined after processing the 2023 operating subsidy forms. All operating subsidy obligations are cumulative, meaning that public housing projects are provided funding in the amount of seven twelfths of prorated eligibility.

For the June and July funding, the Department considered 2023 interim eligibility to provide an interim proration level of approximately 92.15%. The final proration will reflect the difference in the amount of the actual eligibility for final approved PHA subsidy requests and the Appropriation Act. HUD plans to make this round of funding available through eLOCCS no later than June 1, 2023. The next round of funding is expected to be available in eLOCCS no later than August 1, 2023.

PIH Updates List of RAD Transfers

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted an updated <u>list</u> of 2023 Rental Assistance Demonstration (<u>RAD</u>) transfers to the CY <u>2023 operating fund grant</u> <u>processing page</u>. The document, dated May 22, 2023, lists the obligation and max RAD transfer amounts for January and February, March and April, May, and June and July, by PHA code. The document also lists the physical development, application number, removal action date, number of RAD units removed, retroactive removals non-RAD, retroactive removals RAD, standing ACC units as of January 1, 2023, and the cumulative percent.
