HUD Publishes NOFO for Jobs Plus Initiative

Last Friday on <u>grants.gov</u>, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) <u>published</u> the notice of funding opportunity (<u>NOFO</u>) for the 2022 <u>Jobs Plus Initiative</u>. The program is designed to develop locally based approaches to increase earnings and advance employment outcomes for public housing residents through supports such as work readiness, employer linkages, job placement, educational advancement, and financial literacy. The NOFO makes approximately \$16,720,457. HUD will award between \$1.6 million and \$3.7 million, with the maximum amount of funding depending upon development size.

Appendix B of the NOFA refers to an "attached listing of projects" that meet HUD's minimum criteria for development size and resident unemployment, however, there is no attachment or list. The document clarifies that the appearance of a project on this list does not necessarily mean that the project is appropriate for a Jobs Plus program. Note that PHAs that received a Jobs Plus program grant in FY 2017, FY 2018, FY 2019, or FY 2020-2021 are not eligible for FY 2022 grant funds. PHAs that received FY 2014, FY 2015, or FY 2016 Jobs Plus grants may apply for funding under this NOFO. However, public housing projects previously funded through a FY 2014, FY 2015, or FY 2015, or FY 2016 Jobs Plus grant may not be the target of an FY 2022 Jobs Plus application.
