HUD Extends Comment Period for AFFH Interim Final Rule

Today in the Public Inspection Issue of the *Federal Register*, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) published a [prepublication copy](#) of a notice extending the comment period for the [interim final rule](#) rule “Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing Revisions” that was issued on March 3, 2025. The rule originally allowed for a 60-day public comment period, scheduled to close on May 2, 2025. However, due to a technical issue with regulations.gov that might have prevented electronic comment submissions starting around April 28, HUD is providing a 7-day extension to ensure that anyone who might have experienced difficulties has adequate time to submit their feedback. **The new deadline is May 9, 2025.** The official notice is scheduled to be published in the *Federal Register* tomorrow, May 7, 2025.



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
