PIH-REAC Issues Accounting Brief on Calculation of RNP and UNP

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (<u>PIH</u>)—Real Estate Assessment Center (<u>REAC</u>) has issued <u>Accounting Brief #26</u> to provide guidance to account for typical restricted net position (RNP) and unrestricted net position (UNP) transactions. Specifically, the document covers the following topics:

- Definitions of restricted and unrestricted net position
- Typical transactions that relate to RNP and UNP
- How to report RNP and UNP
- Financial data schedule (FDS) details to correctly roll forward RNP and UNP
