HUD Amends Capital Fund Safety and Security Grants Notice, Posts FAQs

HUD’s Office of Capital Improvements ([OCI](#)) has posted an amended version of Notice [PIH 2023-10](#), which provides guidance on emergency capital needs funding for safety and security measures necessary to address crime and drug-related activity or a need for carbon monoxide alarms/detectors, and/or smoke/heat alarms/detectors. HUD will fund \$10 million in capital fund grants this year. [Applications are due](#) no later than June 28, 2023. HUD has also posted a frequently asked questions ([FAQs](#)) document related to the notice.

HUD Extends Deadline to Apply for Lead Hazard Reduction Grant NOFO

HUD’s Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes ([OLHCHH](#)) announced that it has extended the deadline for state and local governments to apply for its Lead Hazard Reduction Grant program notice of funding opportunity ([NOFO](#)) from June 14 to **June 27, 2023**. The NOFO makes available approximately \$711,764,572 in grants to state and local governments for improving health and safety in privately-owned older (pre-1978) homes of low-income families.

According to the announcement, state and local governments that have applied but want to use the extra time now available to improve their submittal may submit a revised application.
