HUD Proposes Changes to FMRs Calculation Methodology

Today in the *Federal Register*, HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research (<u>PD&R</u>) published a <u>notice</u> proposing changes to the methodology used for calculating fair market rents (<u>FMRs</u>) to better determine payment standards and related parameters for HUD programs.

Specifically, HUD is proposing two material changes to the calculation of FMRs. The first would be a change in the definition of "recent mover" as used in the recent mover adjustment described in Part A of Section III of the notice. The second would be to retain and expand the use of rent inflation factors calculated by private sector sources as was first done for fiscal year 2023 FMRs. The proposed changes to the FMRs calculation would also affect small area fair market rents (SAFMRs).

HUD seeks public comment on the proposed changes. The due date for comments is **July 24**, **2023**. The notice also responds to public comments that were submitted on the publication of fiscal year 2023 FMRs.

NLIHC Publishes Out of Reach 2023

The National Low-Income Housing Coalition (NLIHC) has published *Out of Reach 2023*, a report on wages and rents throughout the country. In an accompanying <u>press release</u>, NLIHC described this year's report as follows:

NLIHC's 'Out of Reach 2023' report shows how high rents resulting from rapid rent growth during the pandemic and the end of many pandemic-era benefit programs are combining to exacerbate the financial insecurity of low-income renters, leading to higher eviction filing rates and increased homelessness in some communities.

NLIHC has also updated its interactive <u>Out of Reach website</u> that allows users to compare data from their metropolitan area and county with other metropolitan areas and counties within their state.
