The document lists the obligation and max RAD transfer amounts for January and February, March and April, and May and June, by PHA code. The document also lists the physical development, application number, removal action date, number of RAD units removed, retroactive removals non-RAD, retroactive removals RAD, standing ACC units as of January 1, 2022, and the cumulative percent.
