HUD Posts Healthy Homes and Weatherization Cooperation Demonstration NOFO

Tuesday on [grants.gov](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) [posted](#) the notice of funding opportunity ([NOFO](#)) for the fiscal year (FY) 2024 Healthy Homes and Weatherization Cooperation Demonstration program. The NOFO makes approximately \$6,206,455 available to support demonstrations in communities that provide housing interventions in lower-income households conducted under the joint coordination between HUD's Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes ([OLHCHH](#)) and the Department of Energy's Weatherization Assistance program. The grants are intended to facilitate the leveraging of assets from both programs and support the exploration of different models of service delivery. HUD Awards \$85 Million to Increase Housing Supply and Lower Housing Costs

In a [press release](#) yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it is awarding \$85 million in grant funding under the Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing ([PRO Housing](#)) program, which supports communities that are actively taking steps to identify and remove barriers to affordable housing production and preservation.

The 21 winners of the inaugural PRO Housing competition will update state and local housing plans, revise land use policies, streamline the permitting process, provide construction funds, and take other actions to create more housing-forward communities. Grants will also be used to preserve existing affordable housing units, provide development subsidies to create new affordable units, and increase access to homeownership. According to the announcement, later this year, HUD will make an additional \$100 million available for round two of the competition.
