HUD to Host Second Round of Capital Fund Guidebook Training Webinars

HUD's Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) has announced that it will be hosting the second round of a series of six webinars on the Capital Fund Guidebook. The purpose of the training is to help PHAs understand the more recent changes in Capital Fund requirements and the Capital Fund program at large. Topics and dates are as follows:

- Eligible Activities July 11, 2022
- Obligations and Expenditures July 25, 2022
- CF Formula/DDTF August 8, 2022
- Planning/Submission September 6, 2022
- EPIC September 12, 2022 (Only those persons who have attended the Planning/Submission webinar will be eligible to register for the EPIC webinar)
- Other Federal Requirements & Sanctions September 19, 2022
