HUD Posts Presentation Slides for HIP Implementation Notice Webinar

On the Housing Information Portal ([HIP](#)) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) has posted the [presentation slides](#) for the HIP Implementation Notice webinar that was held on May 21, 2024. The recording accompanying the slides is listed as “coming soon.”

As you recall, HUD issued the [HIP implementation notice](#) on April 24, 2024. The notice describes the process for PHAs and their software vendors to transition from the Inventory Management System/PIH Information Center ([IMS/PIC](#)) to HIP, which will be the official system of record that HUD will use to determine Public Housing Capital Fund and Operating Fund grant amounts and to assess statutory and regulatory compliance in the Public Housing, Housing Choice Voucher, and Mod Rehab programs.

HUD Announces FY 2023 FSS and ROSS-SC Awards

In a [press release](#) last Friday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced \$44 million in fiscal year 2023 funding through the Family Self Sufficiency ([FSS](#)) program and the Resident Opportunity and Self-Sufficiency ([ROSS](#)) Service Coordinator ([ROSS-SC](#)) program. Funding from both programs will be used to equip residents with the tools and resources they need to achieve financial stability, lower housing costs, and build generational wealth. HUD Publishes FY 2024 ROSS-SC NOFO

Last Thursday on [grants.gov](#), HUD’s Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) [published](#) the fiscal year (FY) 2024 notice of funding opportunity ([NOFO](#)) for the Resident Opportunity and Self-Sufficiency ([ROSS](#)) service coordinator ([ROSS-SC](#)) program. The NOFO makes approximately \$40,000,000 available for the provision of service coordinators for supportive services and other activities designed to help public housing residents attain economic and housing self-sufficiency.
