HUD Posts Presentation Slides for 2022 FYI Competitive NOFA

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) has posted the [presentation slides](#) for the FY 2022 Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) competitive notice of funding availability (NOFA) that was published on June 7, 2022. Funding of approximately \$15,300,000 is available through this NOFA, which makes Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) assistance available to PHAs in partnership with Public Child Welfare Agencies (PCWAs). The application deadline date changed from August 9 to **August 8, 2022**.
