#### **HUD Posts Document on HCV Program CY 2022 Implementation**

### **HUD Announces Latest in PH Repositioning Webinar Series**

HUD has <u>announced</u> that it will be hosting the latest in its series of training webinars on repositioning public housing. The series enables PHAs to understand multiple aspects of the repositioning process and identify strategies and resources available to successfully complete it. As such, the series is relevant for PHA directors, staff, residents, board members, and others working with PHAs to develop and execute a repositioning strategy.

The latest scheduled webinar, titled "Repositioning Non-Dwelling Property: Overview of Tools and Strategic Tips," will provide an overview of the tools available to PHAs to reposition non-dwelling public housing real property (i.e., vacant land, community buildings, administrative buildings, maintenance/storage buildings). It will also discuss options under Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD), Section 18 demolition, Section 18 disposition, and Part 200 retention. Additionally, the webinar will cover timing and sequencing issues, including when PHAs are closing out their public housing programs.

The live web conference is scheduled for Wednesday, July 27, 2022, from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. Eastern time. Click <u>here</u> for more information, including <u>instructions</u> on how to register.

# **HUD Opens Applications for Veteran Housing Rehab Grants**

Last Friday on <u>Grants.gov</u>, HUD <u>announced</u> that it is making available up to \$10,445,980 in funding for the Veterans Housing Rehabilitation and Modification Pilot Program (<u>VHRMP</u>). Through the VHRM program, the funds are awarded to nonprofit organizations and may be used to rehabilitate and modify the primary residence of veterans who are low-income and living with disabilities or to provide grantees' affiliates with technical, administrative, and training support in connection with those services. Grants will be competitively awarded up to \$1 million each to selected applicants.
