HUD Posts CY 2024 Per Unit Subsidy by AMP Report

On the [HOTMA Resources](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) has [posted](#) the [CY 2024 Per Unit Subsidy by AMP](#) report, which shows to be updated as of July 9, 2024. According to the webpage, PHAs will use this Excel spreadsheet to help establish the alternative rents for the stated calendar year for non-public housing over-income (NPHOI) families.

HUD Posts Section 3 Labor Hours Tracking Form

On the HUD Exchange [Resource Library](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) [posted](#) a [Section 3 Labor Hours Tracking Form](#), an Excel spreadsheet that can be used by grantees to track and evaluate the cumulative total labor hours, Section 3 labor hours, and Targeted Section 3 labor hours worked for Section 3 projects using payroll data. As explained in the webpage, the labor hours worked by employees of each business on the project are listed and tracked in a separate tab/sheet. The cumulative labor hours, Section 3 labor hours, and Targeted Section 3 labor hours worked on a Section 3 project are automatically calculated on the “Totals” tab/sheet.

HUD Announces New ConnectHomeUSA Initiative Communities

In a [press release](#) yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that [97 new communities](#) have been selected to participate in the ConnectHomeUSA ([CHUSA](#)) initiative. Of the total number of communities accepted, 59 are joining the Tier 1 cohort, which consists of communities that are just beginning to address the digital divide, and 38 communities were accepted in the Tier 2 cohort, reserved for returning CHUSA communities that have demonstrated a commitment to deepening their work.

This is the first time since 2020 that HUD has accepted new communities. This phase of the initiative has expanded its reach to include not only PHAs, Tribally Designated Housing Entities (TDHEs), and Multifamily housing providers but also HUD Continuum of Care and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS grantees. The new communities were selected based on their demonstrated commitment to bridging the digital divide for HUD-assisted residents.



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
