HUD Announces HOTMA Compliance Delay

This afternoon, the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment Officials ([NAHRO](#)) [announced](#) that today at its Summer Symposium, Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary Richard J. Monocchio stated that HUD will delay compliance for Sections 102 and 104 of the Housing Opportunity Through Modernization Act (HOTMA) until January 1, 2025. However, PHAs must still update their administrative plans and ACOPs by January 1, 2024. The change will bring needed relief to PHAs as they implement the changes set forth in the [final rule](#) published earlier this year.
