HUD Launches Small Area Fair Market Rent Website

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has launched the small area fair market rent (SAFMR) <u>website</u>, which contains videos and other training resources to help PHAs adopt SAFMRs. The new site also includes an interactive <u>dashboard</u> that shows which PHAs have adopted SMFMRs and how many Housing Choice Voucher (<u>HCV</u>) program units are associated with SAFMRs nationally. It also allows the user to drill down to the state and PHA-level.

According to the new website, the dashboard data with respect to program units is updated monthly with the most current and relevant data from HUD administrative systems. The classification of PHAs with SAFMRs is updated as soon as they are identified as such to HUD. The SAFMR dashboard is accessible both internally to HUD employees and externally to the public.

HUD Posts Document on Tips to Increase PBV Unit Occupancy

On the project-based vouchers (PBVs) <u>website</u>, HUD has posted a new <u>document</u> titled "Tips to Increase Project-Based Voucher Unit Occupancy." The two-page document, dated July 2023, contains strategies that PHAs and property owners can implement for PBV units to improve occupancy.
