HUD Posts Shortfall Funding Materials, Announces Trainings

On the <u>2023 Operating Fund Shortfall Funding</u> webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted the following materials:

- Shortfall <u>notice</u>
- List of eligible PHAs and the amount they are eligible to receive
- Shortfall <u>schedule</u>

Additionally, in an <u>email</u> yesterday via HUD's Financial Management Division (FMD) <u>mailing list</u>, HUD announced that it will be holding two training sessions on submitting a shortfall application and shortfall appeal next week:

- Tuesday, July 25, 2023, from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Eastern time
- Wednesday, July 26, 2023, from 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. Eastern time

The email also reminds eligible PHAs that they must submit their shortfall applications for federal fiscal year 2023 by **August 17, 2023**, through the public housing portal. PHAs that would like to appeal their shortfall eligibility status or funding amount can submit an appeal, also through the public housing portal, by **August 17, 2023**. The email includes the application <u>user guide</u> and the appeal <u>user guide</u>.

HUD Posts FAQs for Housing Mobility-Related Services NOFO

On the <u>Housing Mobility</u> webpage, HUD has posted a frequently asked questions (<u>FAQs</u>) document for the mobility-related services notice of funding opportunity (<u>NOFO</u>) that was published on June 1, 2023. The NOFO makes available \$25,000,000 to expand housing choices for Housing Choice Voucher (<u>HCV</u>) families with children by increasing access to opportunity neighborhoods with high-performing schools, access to jobs, low crime, parks, and other amenities. The application deadline date is **August 30, 2023**.

Nomination Deadline Extended for Secretary's Award for Healthy Homes

In an email yesterday, HUD announced that the deadline to submit nominations for the 2023 HUD <u>Secretary's Award for Excellence in Healthy Homes</u> has been extended to **August 10**, **2023**. The award recognizes agencies, organizations, and Tribes that improve healthy homes while advancing affordable housing, strengthening environmental justice, and addressing climate resilience. Nominations should show the success of innovative solutions, with quantifiable health, economic, and/or societal outcomes. In 2023, the award will be presented to a single organization or group who best exemplifies the holistic approach required to create a healthy homes culture.
